Dear Professor Sillett:

I recently read your June 13 letter in support of the Bohemian Club's NTMP. It did not appear that your observations were based on the NTMP which is officially on file. This email is just a follow-up to my phone calls to your office.

Are you perhaps privy to a new NTMP which is being circulated privately has not yet been filed with CDF? Several points in your letter suggest you may have reviewed an entirely new document. Yet, to the public, it appears as though you are supporting a plan which has been strongly criticized and significant parts of which I doubt you would approve: failure to achieve sustained yield, inadequate disclosure and protection of old growth etc.

This same confusion arose recently in another instance and I attach a copy of that letter which may be of interest.
